I. Policy

The following driving behaviors will be in violation of the rules and shall not be tolerated on the University premises; disciplinary and/or legal actions will be taken against any violation of those behaviors:

- 1. Driving in the wrong direction
- 2. Crossing the speed limits of 20 KM/Hour
- 3. Stunts and other hazardous driving behavior
- 4. Parking in "No Parking" areas or handicapped spaces without proper documents and prior permission
- 5. Overnight parking without prior permission and notification to the University Security

The University management is not responsible for the safety of vehicles and/or their contents, left in the parking lot.

Concerned authorities, such as the Ministry of the Interior, can be called to inspect any vehicles remaining in the University parking lot after two days to ensure that they do not pose a threat to the University without any responsibility of the University.

Person with Disability Considerations:

GUST allows for an accessible parking spaces to enable students, staff and visitors with mobility limitations, health conditions, or other challenges to have safe access to buildings and services in the university. These parking spaces and drop-off points along with ramp are kept for persons with disability. This is purposely located near the entrance of the building, and painted with an accessibility symbol.
