Any course with code starting with ARAB, ART, CHIN, ENGL, FREN, GRMN, HIST, , MUSC, PHIL, SPAN and THTR.

Arab Heritage and Cultural Diversity (1 course - 3 credits)

Mathematics and Natural Sciences (4 courses - 12 credits)
